APPLICANT DECLARATION

Yes, I (the applicant) agree:

- 1. To UQ communicating with me via electronic means. This may include communications relating to UQ-organised events;
- 2. That if offered a place in ESP, I will comply with UQ's admission and enrolment rules, and important dates as set by UQ, while part of FSP:
- 3. To notify the ESP Coordinator if there is any change to the information I have provided in my application;
- 4. To permit UQ to release details of my academic progress to my school/college and parents/guardian as stated in my application;
- 5. - 3. As an ESP student, my tuition fees are waived, but I am fully responsible for additional educational expenses while studying at UQ;
- 4. If offered a place in ESP, this offer is conditional on approval by my school;
- 5. Submitting this application is not a guarantee of a place in ESP;
- 6. My application will be assessed to ensure I meet the eligibility requirements for ESP;
- 7. Some courses have quotas and additional eligibility criteria that I will be required to meet, if relevant (e.g. language tests, auditions);
- 8. While UQ does its best to accommodate all eligible ESP applicants, if large numbers of applications are received for specific courses, not all eligible applicants will be offered a place. In this instance, UQ Admissions (in consultation with other relevant UQ departments) will work with the applicant to see if another ESP course is available;
- 9. Timetable preferencing opens for two weeks from mid January. The class timetable is released two weeks prior to classes starting.
- 10. It is my responsibility to manage my high school and ESP workload;
- 11. The academic implications of withdrawing from ESP as outlined in the 2024 ESP Rules and Guidelines;
- 12. **My final ESP grade will remain on my permanent record with UQ.** All official grades on a student's record may be used to calculate a Grade Point Average (GPA) for applications for study in undergraduate, honours, postgraduate or research studies in the future;
- 13. UQ complies with the Australian and Queensland privacy laws and guidelines. UQ only collects, stores, uses and discloses personal information in accordance with *Policy 1.60.02—Privacy Management*. Personal information supplied in this ESP application will only be used for University purposes in accordance with the ESP application.
