How to submit an online ESP application

- 1. **CHECK** that you meet eligibility criteria only applications that meet eligibility criteria will be progressed.
- 2. **READ** the ESP rules and guidelines by submitting your application you are agreeing to abide by the rules and guidelines.
- **3. SELECT** WRIT1999 as your course. Please ensure you select the correct Semester i.e. Summer Semester 2023 (which includes January 2024 courses).
- **4. OBTAIN** approval from your **parent/guardian and school** the completed, signed form must be submitted.
- 5. Follow these instructions carefully so your application is not denied.

Evidence and Document Upload • You may provide scanned copies of your original documents.

You must retain your original supporting documents for the duration of your studies at UQ.
 You may be requested, at any time throughout your studies, to provide original documentation for verification. Failure to provide the original documents for verification when requested may result in withdrawal of the offer of a place, cancellation of enrolment and, where relevant, rescinding of any awards conferred if the qualifications used as the basis for admission are unable to be verified.
