How to submit an online ESP application

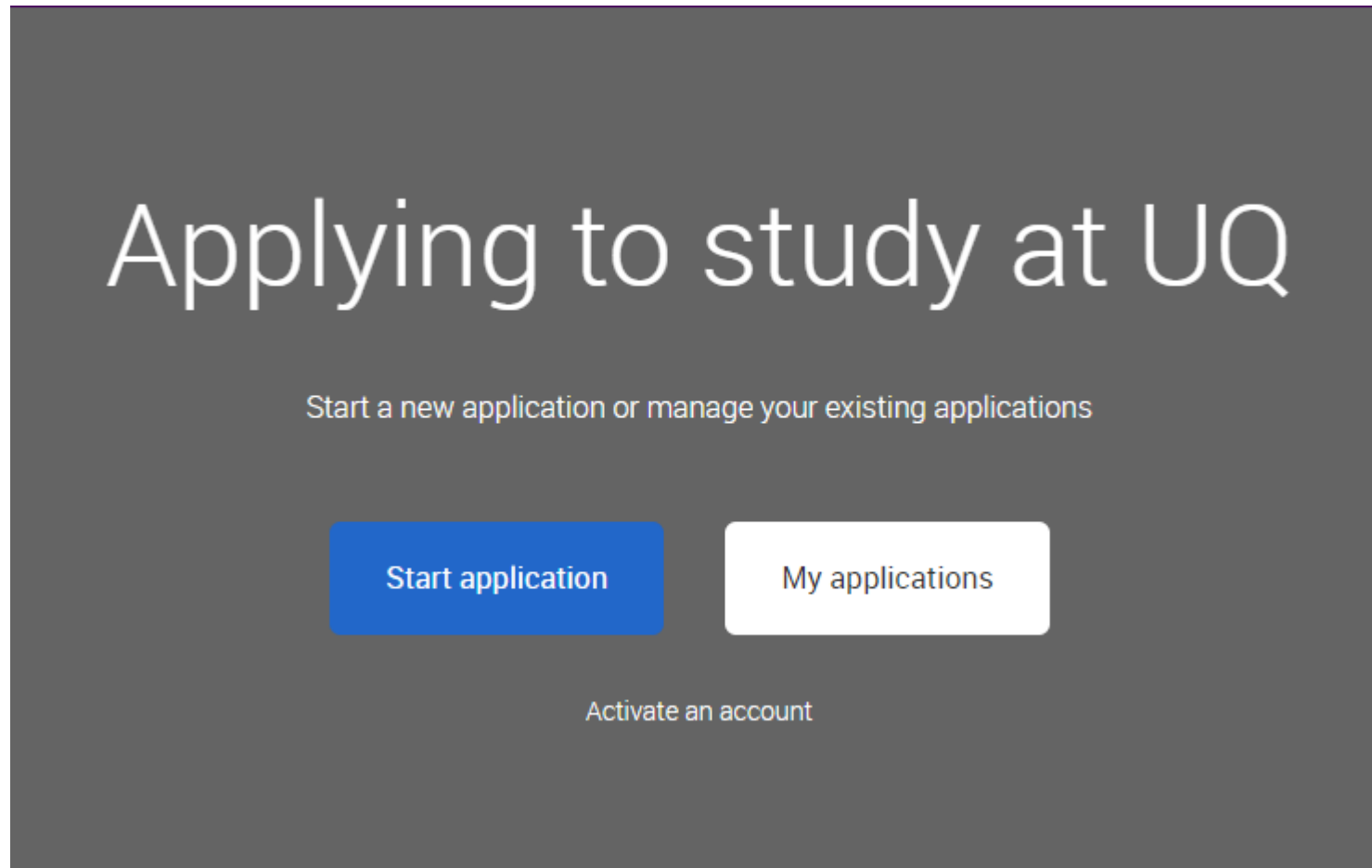
1. **CHECK** that you meet eligibility criteria – only applications that meet eligibility criteria will be progressed.
2. **READ** the ESP rules and guidelines – by submitting your application you are agreeing to abide by the rules and guidelines.
3. **CHOOSE** an ESP course offering from esp.uq.edu.au – select ONE or TWO preferences for your application. Ensure you read the Electronic Course Profile (ECP) for the course before applying. Your selection cannot be changed at a later date and applications for ineligible courses will be denied.
4. Only apply once you have parent/guardian as well as school permission – the signed form must be submitted.
5. Follow these instructions carefully so your application is not denied.



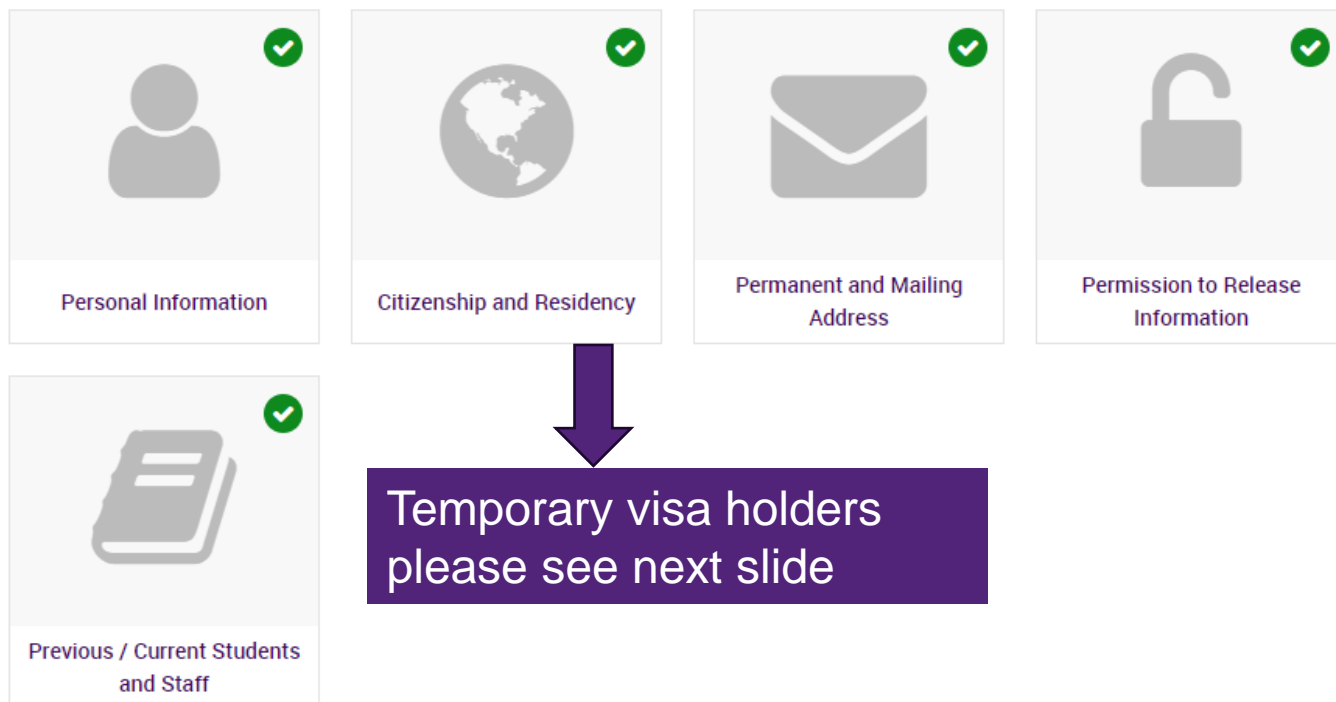

Shorter Form Credentials

Acceptance in SFCs does not make you eligible for an Australian student visa.



The final year of study to be undertaken within the 5 years immediately prior to commencement at UQ. Assessed on a case by case basis. Evidence is required via an official academic document.

- You may be requested, at any time throughout your studies, to provide original documentation for verification. Failure to provide the original documents for verification when requested may result in withdrawal of the offer of a place, cancellation of enrolment and, where relevant, rescinding of any awards conferred if the qualifications used as the basis for admission are unable to be verified.
