How to submit an online ESP application

- **1.** CHECK that you meet eligibility criteria only applications that meet eligibility criteria will be progressed.
- 2. READ the ESP rules and guidelines by submitting your application you are agreeing to abide by the rules and guidelines.
- **3. SELECT** WRIT1999 as your course. Please ensure you select the correct Semester e.g. Summer Semester 2024 (which includes January 2025 courses).
- 4. OBTAIN approval from your parent/guardian <u>and</u> school the completed, signed form must be submitted.
- 5. Follow these instructions carefully so your application is not denied.

Evidence is required via an official academic document.

I have taken an English language proficiency test. Test must have been taken within the 2 years immediately prior to commencement at UQ.

I have registered, or intend to register, to take an English language proficiency test.

I have completed a Bridging English Course at ICTE or UQ College.

Evidence is required via a certificate of achievement.

I have successfully completed a recognised bachelor or master degree program, or have completed at least 2 years of full time equivalent post-secondary study (at diploma level or higher), from an accredited university or institution where English was the language of instruction and assessment in the program undertaken.

The final year of study to be undertaken within the 5 years immediately prior to commencement at UQ. Assessed on a case by case basis. Evidence is required via an official academic document.

I have completed senior secondary schooling from a designated country* where the medium of instruction is English.
*Examples of designated countries: Australia, Canada, New Zealand, Singapore, South Africa, Republic of Ireland, United Kingdom, United States. More designated countries are listed here

I have worked in a primarily English-speaking professional environment for a period of 3 years or more immediately prior to commencement at UQ. Assessed on a case by case basis. Evidence is required via letters of employment stating the dates of employment and the position held, and that the work was undertaken in a primarily English-speaking environment. If you are undertaking Qld Senior English, you can select that option.

Evidence and Document Upload

- · You may provide scanned copies of your original documents.
- · You must retain your original supporting documents for the duration of your studies at UQ.
- You may be requested, at any time throughout your studies, to provide original documentation for verification. Failure to provide the original documents for verification when requested may result in
 withdrawal of the offer of a place, cancellation of enrolment and, where relevant, rescinding of any awards conferred if the qualifications used as the basis for admission are unable to be verified.

The following documentation is required to support your application.

- Lividence of passing grade in Queensland Senior English or equivalent
- Academic transcript including grading scale
