



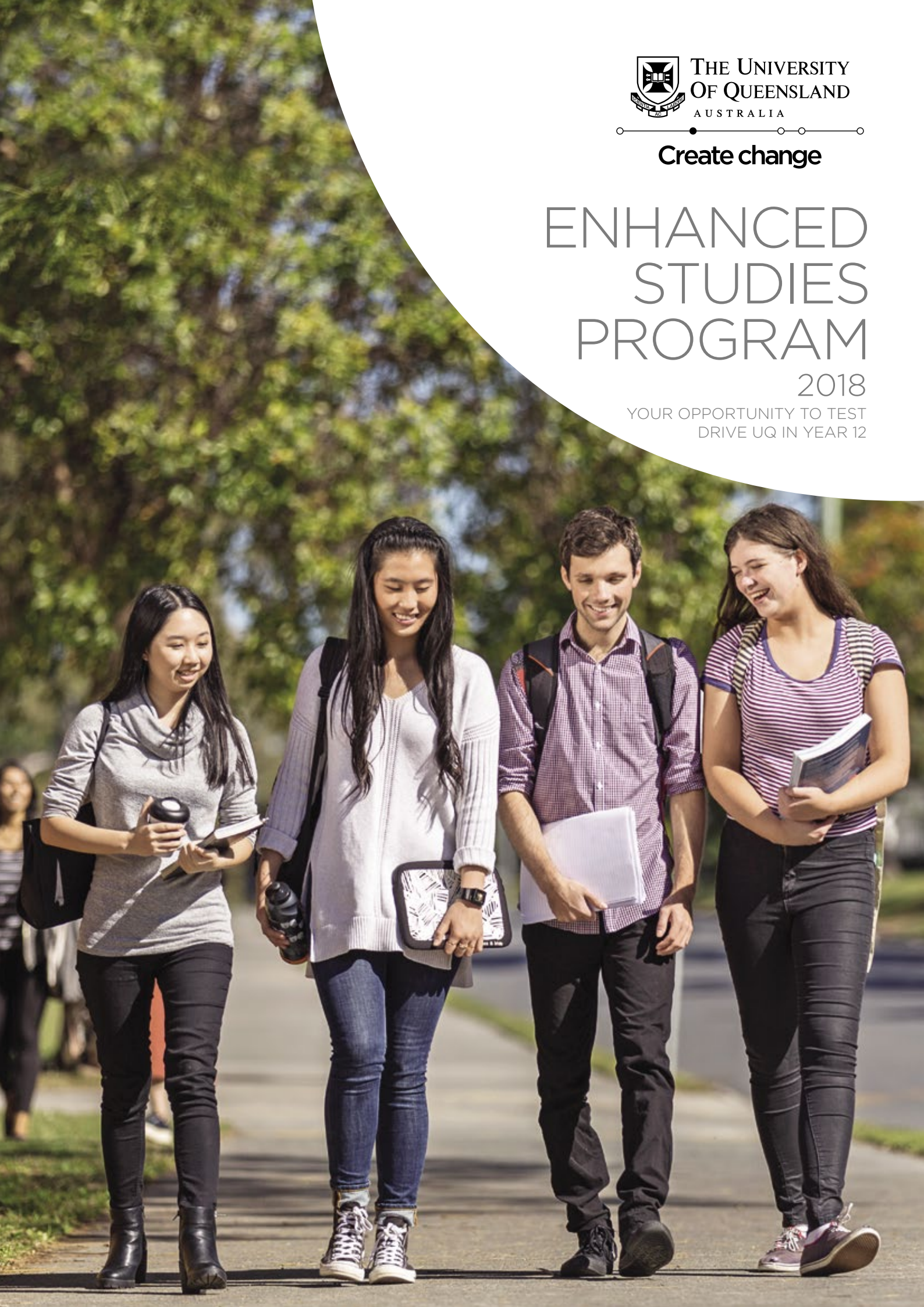

Complete the online application form at **esp.uq.edu.au** and upload your Semester 1, Year 11 report card. You must also upload a permission form signed by your parent/guardian and school principal.

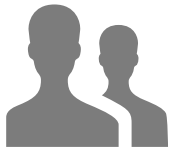
